
Action:

2. The Court acted and approved the re-allocation of CSLFRF funds in the amount of \$14,000.00 from water trailer line item to be moved to Precinct #3 to purchase equipment. Commissioner Behrens made the motion and Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
3. The Court acted and approved the re-allocation of CSLFRF funds in the amount of \$16,906.04 from old jail line item to be moved to Precinct #3 to purchase equipment. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0
4. The Court considered and approved the re-allocation of CSLFRF funds in the amount of \$30,480.19 from dump truck line item to be moved to Precinct #3 to purchase equipment. Commissioner Behrens made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0
5. The Court acted and approved the re-allocation of CSLFRF funds in the amount of \$48,133.58 from interest revenue line item to be moved to Precinct #3 to purchase equipment. Commissioner Bratton made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0
6. The Court acted and approved the purchase of a 2025 Chevy Silverado 2500 HD 4wd crew cab work truck from Caldwell County Chevrolet in the amount of \$51,900.00 for precinct #3. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
