Public Comment:

BILLS:

Bills for August 26, 2024 were presented and approved with Commissioner Anderson making the motion and County Judge Frank Trull seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0

Elected Officials/Department Heads: Sheriff Andrews reported to the court that Snider IT would like to replace all battery backups at the sheriff’s office. Sheriff Andrews feel that they are still good and do not need to be replaced at all and if they do it can be done at that time. Sheriff Andrews also stated that the jail is equipped with a generator that will kick on in about 3 seconds of losing power.

County Judge reported on the repeater project and that Texas communications was approved as a subcontractor. The Waldrip Bridge update was also given by Judge Trull with 70% of the Bridge in Coleman County and 30% in McCulloch County.

Discussion: 1. Chief Appraiser Zane Brandenburger gave a presentation with a worksheet of the Tax Rate Calculations.



Action:

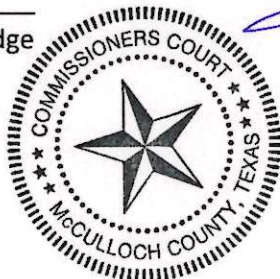

2. The Court acted and approved the request by Dolores Huerta to use the Courthouse Grounds for a fundraiser bake sale and street tacos on Saturday August 31, 2024. Commissioner Behrens making the motion and Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
3. The Court acted and approved a Pre-Adjudication Detention Services agreement between Guadalupe County Juvenile Board/Services and McCulloch County for juvenile offender detention. Commissioner Behrens made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0
4. The Court considered and approved the contract for Detention Services between Tom Green County and McCulloch County for juvenile offenders. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0

The Court acted and approved an Interlocal Agreement Cooperation Agreement-Detention Expansion Project Services between Tom Green County and McCulloch County for secure Pre-Adjudication Detention Services for juvenile offenders. 6. The Court acted and approved an Order Prohibiting outdoor burning. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
7. The Court acted and approved an Interlocal Agreement between the Concho Valley Transit, a program of the Concho Valley Council of Governments and McCulloch County for transportation

- services for the citizens of McCulloch County. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
8. The court acted and approved on opening the sealed bids for lawn maintenance for the Courthouse and Library grounds. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
 9. The court acted and approved on awarding the bid for the Courthouse Lawn maintenance for FY 2024-2025 to Dean Gibson doing business as D & L Woodworks and Lawn Care. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
 10. The court acted and approved on awarding the bid for the Library Lawn maintenance for FY 2024-2025 to Chad Everett doing business as Bridge Street Garden Market, Landscaping and Irrigation. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0

 13. The court acted and approved the closing of the McCulloch County Library for inventory. This was reinstated from a tabled action item on August 12, 2024. Commissioner Bratton made the motion with Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0
